*For renewal of Registered Counsellor certification, which applies to Clinical Members and above, whose Registered Counsellor certificate has expired since end of June 2019, you would have received an email from us regarding the renewal process and payment details. Please take note that the approval status of your submission will take 1-2 months. We seek your kind understanding and patience.*

*The SAC Professional Indemnity Insurance is generally offered to Provisional Clinical Members and above. Notwithstanding, please note that pursuant to Article 5.5.1 of the SAC Constitution, it is mandatory for all Registered Counsellors to possess professional indemnity coverage.
