Renewal of Registered Counsellor and Professional Indemnity Insurance

For renewal of Registered Counsellor certification, which applies to Clinical Members and above, whose Registered Counsellor certificate has expired since end of June 2019, you would have received an email from us regarding the renewal process and payment details. Please take note that the approval status of your submission will take 1-2 months. We seek your kind understanding and patience.

The SAC Professional Indemnity Insurance is generally offered to Provisional Clinical Members and above. Notwithstanding, please note that pursuant to Article 5.5.1 of the SAC Constitution, it is mandatory for all Registered Counsellors to possess professional indemnity coverage. To opt in, kindly access https://forms.gle/PLYX4VCGZ1BTMa4F8 to indicate your interest. Please make payment only after you have received an invoice from us. If you are covered under your organisation, please write to admin@sacsingapore.org to request for the Professional Indemnity Exemption Form.

If you have sent in before, you will not be required to submit again. Please also take note that the validity period of the insurance is July 2019 to June 2020 and coverage will only take place upon receipt of payment.
