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Renewal of Registered Counsellor

All Registered Counsellor (RC) renewals will be valid for two (2) years from the date of EXCO approval. To facilitate the processing of your renewal, please submit the declaration of 400 clinical hours + 50 CPD* hours at least one (1) month prior to the expiry of your RC. These hours should be clocked within your RC validity period.

For example:

RC validity 31 Oct 2020 - 31 Oct 2022

Renewal to be submitted at least one (1) month prior to the expiry i.e. 30 Sep 2022.

Hours clocked from 31 Oct 2020 - 30 Sep 2022 will be accepted for the renewal.

*Fifty (50) hours of continuing professional development (CPD) activities can consist solely of Formal Learning or a combination of Formal Learning and Professional Contribution Activities. Formal Learning is defined as participation in workshops, seminars, or training in counselling or a closely related field. Please submit an official certificate OR letter of attendance for each workshop / course / seminar attended.

GRIEF COUNSELLING USING NARRATIVE PRACTICES

Overview:

Carolyn Markey addresses the difficult areas of grief and loss with practical helps based on Narrative Therapy concepts. Highlights include:

- 1. Discussing traditional ideas of grief and loss including the conventional assumptions of Grief Psychology contrasted with the ideas that shape Narrative Practices in addressing grief
- 2. Looking at how death is an end to a life but not necessarily a relationship and remembering a person with material from Barbara Myerhoff
- 3. Categories of Enguiry and group work will also be used in practice groups
- 4. Addressing cultural messages about loss and death will be discussed and how they interact with persons experiencing grief
- Delving into the use of re-membering conversational maps, the absent but implicit, definitional ceremonies with outsider-witness practices - all used and practiced within small groups
