MISSION

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ABOUT SAC

The Singapore Association for Counselling (SAC) is the professional body representing counsellors, psychotherapists, counselling educators and students in Singapore. SAC has come a long way – pioneered in 1982 by Mr Anthony Yeo from Counselling and Care Centre together with a small group of counsellors.

Between 1996 – 1999, a Paper was developed by the EXCO to propose standards for the Recognition and Licensing of Professional Counsellors in Singapore. This Paper was presented to the then Ministry of Community Development (MCD) in 1999 but was rejected as the counsellor fraternity was considered too small.

In 1999, Constitutional amendments related to training standards for membership were approved by the Registry of Societies and implemented for new membership applications. Subsequently, SAC's first Code of Ethics was accepted at its Extraordinary General Meeting.

In the year 2000, SAC established new guidelines for the accreditation of counsellor training courses in Singapore to ensure clinical practice and supervision components were adequately in place.

SAC Register of Counsellors was established during its 20th Annual General Meeting in March 2003. The first SAC Website was launched. The SAC Constitution was amended for more clarity on its definition of a trained and qualified counsellor with emphasis on the details of training, practicum, and clinical supervision.

SAC partnered the Ministry of Community Development and Sports, and the National Council of Social Service (NCSS) to develop standard counselling courses. The First Joint Committee meeting involved SAC, NCSS, and SSTI. This was followed by MSF (then MCYS), SASW and the NUS Social Work Department. The first Course Recognition Manual was launched in December 2005.

New Membership Categories were introduced, and the SAC Constitution went through a major review and update in 2013. SAC became a full member of the NCSS since April 2015. In October 2015, SAC Ethics Manual of Procedures was launched by our Guest of Honour, Minister of State for the Ministry of Health, Dr Amy Khor at our inaugural Symposium attended by 500 delegates.

In 2016, SAC's Register of Clinical Supervisors was established during our 34th Annual General Meeting. The new Clinical Supervision Standards and Procedures document was approved. SAC also established a New Clinical Supervision Components and Standards for New Clinical Supervisor Applicants and was approved at the 35th AGM in 2017 to be in effect from June 2018.

On 03 November 2017, the new SAC Logo, Website, and Member Portal was launched by Mayor Denise Phua at the half-day 35th Anniversary Conference. At the end of 2018, the EXCO decided to terminate the Secretariat services with the Singapore Professional Centre. From 2019, SAC employed its own staff to operate its secretariat and engaged external accounting services.

Membership passed the millennium mark in 2020 and in the following year saw the Association upgraded our external relations with many local as well as overseas friends, mostly notable was the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) signed with the Hong Kong Professional Counselling Association.

SAC marked our 40th anniversary in 2022 with a series of webinars, a symposium and a members' dinner where the first Singaporean academic journal of counselling was launched.

SAC hosted a gathering of six ASEAN counselling associations in Singapore on 3 November 2023, where an MOU was signed to establish a formal regional network.

In 2024, the SAC signed an MOU with the Art Therapists' Association Singapore (ATAS), the Association for Play Therapy (Singapore) (APTS), and the Association for Marital and Family Therapy Singapore (AMFTS) during the Singapore Counselling & Psychotherapy Symposium, witnessed by Mr Eric Chua, Senior Parliamentary Secretary for MCCY and MSF. The MOU aims to foster professional development, encourage cross-disciplinary learning, and provide more comprehensive, holistic care for individuals seeking mental health support in Singapore.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The 28th Executive Committee of the Singapore Association for Counselling (SAC) is pleased to present its Annual Report for 2024. The year under review witnessed several emerging shifts in the wider landscape and it will be worthy to highlight SAC's role in some of these.

I am pleased to report that our membership remains on a growing trend. As of 31st December 2024, our total membership stood at 2,033, crossing the 2,000-mark for the first time! This trend was similarly noted for our registered practitioners – Registered Counsellors grew by 22% to 693 (2023: 570) and Registered Clinical Supervisors, by 14% to 158 (2023: 139). Financially, our surplus grew by 38% to \$111,609 (2023: \$80,899) and total funds increased by 17% to \$757,245 (2023: \$645,636).

The 42nd Annual General Meeting held on 12th April 2024 saw the election of the 28th Executive Committee (EXCO). The team committed to furthering the good work from the 27th EXCO in amplifying SAC's footprint and impact on the fraternity and beyond.

Across the year, SAC held many events that aimed to engage members in meaningful manners, with the strong support from dedicated volunteers and stakeholders. Some of these included

- Plenary Sharing on Trauma (11th March 2024) by the School and College Counsellors Sub-Committee,
- "Your Growth Zone" (2nd June 2024) by the Membership Sub-Committee,
- Private Practitioners' Networking Hi-Tea (30th July 2024),
- New Members' Orientation (3rd August 2024) by the Membership Sub-Committee,
- Communications Training (7th August 2024), a collaboration between SAC and the Singapore Psychological Society,
- "Addressing Youth Addiction: Insights and Best Practices" (3rd September 2024) by the School and College Counsellors Sub-Committee,
- "Nervous System 101: Regulation in Action" (10th October 2024) by the Community Counsellors Sub-Committee,
- Singapore Counselling & Psychotherapy Symposium (22nd November 2024), and
- Volunteers' Appreciation Dinner (4th December 2024) by the Membership Sub-Committee.

Notably, SAC was privileged to have Mr Eric Chua, Senior Parliamentary Secretary for the Ministry of Culture, Community and Youth (MCCY) and Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF) as the Guest-of-Honour, whom witnessed the signing of the memorandum of understanding between SAC and partner associations: Association for Marital and Family Therapy Singapore (AMFTS), Association for Play Therapy Singapore (APTS) and Art Therapists' Association Singapore (ATAS). This declaration of commitment to advance the role of multidisciplinary practice in the counselling fraternity is a crucial one considering the rapidly evolving landscape.



PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

At the national level, SAC continues to play the role of representing the interests of counsellors and the advancement of counselling in Singapore. Consequent to the establishment of the Counselling Track under the Skills Framework for Social Service in 2023, the sector salary guidelines for counsellors were published for the first time in 2024¹. Beyond salary, SAC has been an active contributor on national and sectorial initiatives such as crisis response (Ministry of Home Affairs), Code of Social Service Practice (MSF) and Family Services Review (MSF). In 2024, we also made a formal declaration to embark on the call for regulation of mental health professions² and expressed our posture on the mental health scene in Singapore³. At the regional level, SAC remains an important partner among fellow associations in sharing best practices and fostering cross-cultural learning. To this end, we have delegates represented at the

- Philippine Guidance and Counselling Association (PGCA)'s 59th Annual and 2024 International Conference held in Manila (16th-18th May 2024),
- RISE Regional Counselling Convention 2024 held in Malaysia (7th-9th November 2024), where the 3rd Meeting for the ASEAN Counselling Organisations' Network (ASCON) was also held, and
- Brunei Counselling Symposium (12th-14th November 2024).

In a world that is increasingly interconnected yet often fragmented, the role of counsellors has never been more vital. We are entrusted with the profound responsibility of fostering emotional well-being and resilience in the face of adversity. This year, we will focus on enhancing our secretariat office's capabilities and infrastructure, professional development programmes, and fostering a closer stakeholder network. Together, we will continue to build a society where everyone has access to compassionate and effective mental health care.

On behalf of all members, I want to thank the Chairpersons and member-volunteers of all Boards, Sub-Committees and Groups for advancing the aspirations of SAC. I thank my Vice Presidents – Ms Jenny Giam and Ms Hema Gurnani, and all other colleagues on the 28th Executive Committee for their dedication and commitment to SAC's causes. Also special mention to Ms Angelina Hing, who serves as SAC's Honorary Legal Advisor. I would also like to take this opportunity to extend my appreciation to partners such as FJC, MHA, MOE, MSF, NCSS, IMH, AMFTS, APTS, ATAS, SPS, Republic Polytechnic, Kaplan Singapore, Raffles Institution, Hwa Chong Institution, and all others for their support rendered to SAC during the year. Finally, my utmost gratitude to the secretariat office, Ms Sandra Lim and Mr Sebastian Li for their hard work, and our finance team from Genesis Consulting & Solutions, Ms Sarah Phua and Ms Lee Pei Yee for their diligent work.



To all members, SAC can only move towards the collective aspirations with your involvement and partnership. I am deeply grateful for your participation and support at our events. I hope you will be inspired to join us in one way or another in the near future to advance SAC's causes.

Thank you for your commitment to the Singapore Association for Counselling. I look forward to yet another inspiring and impactful year ahead.

The School and College Counsellors Sub-Committee (SCCSC) had organised two (2) events in the year 2024.

The first event was a Plenary Sharing – Trauma (Family Violence and/or Child Abuse) event held on 11th March 2024 from 1pm to 4pm at Hwa Chong Institution. The aim of the event was to provide a platform for fellow school and college counsellors to network and grow professionally.

We remain grateful to Hwa Chong Institution for sponsoring the venue and thankful for the support from the Institute of Mental Health, the Ministry of Education, and Child Protective Service (CPS) of the Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF), who had kindly sent established medical and counselling professionals to share insights about the impact of trauma—especially in the areas of family violence and/or child abuse—on school-going children. The session also covered the role of school counsellors in reporting and/or managing such cases, relevant reporting/support processes, and statistics. In addition, the discussion focused on how school and college counsellors could complement the work of CPS and CPSC, as well as psychiatrists and psychologists, in supporting students who had experienced trauma, particularly related to family violence and/or child abuse. We were also thankful for the attendance of several 2022–2024 EXCO members of SAC: Ms Hema Gurnani, 2nd Vice-President of SAC; Ms Jenny Giam, Honorary Secretary of SAC; and Ms Carolyn Lim, Assistant Honorary Secretary of SAC. The sub-committee had been encouraged by the warm response from SAC members, with approximately 82 participants attending the event.

The second event was a Community of Practice (CoP) - Addressing Youth Addiction: Insights and Best Practices event held on 3rd September 2024 from 6pm to 9pm at Raffles Institution. The CoP is designed to create a supportive environment for knowledge sharing to school and college counsellors. The primary goals were to provide a platform for sharing of knowledge and best practices, and to foster collaboration and continuous learning among members. SCCSC aims to enhance professional development and ensures that fellow school and college counsellors remain at the forefront of innovation and excellence in the school and college counselling field.



We remain grateful to Raffles Institution for sponsoring the venue and thankful for the support from the Association of Professionals Specialising in Addiction Counselling (APSAC), the National Addiction Management Centre (NAMS), the Singapore Anti-Narcotics Association (SANA), Touch Community Services, and WeCare Community Services, who had kindly sent established counselling professionals to discuss their roles in addressing youth addictions and the trends and interventions in the community for youth addiction.

We were also thankful for the attendance of several 2024–2026 EXCO members of SAC: Ms Jenny Giam, 1st Vice-President of SAC; Ms Hema Gurnani, 2nd Vice-President of SAC; Ms Cindy Loh, Assistant Honorary Secretary; and Mr Sam Roberts, Committee Member of EXCO. The sub-committee was encouraged by the warm response from SAC members, with approximately 76 participants attending the event.

A survey was conducted after the event, encouraging us through the positive responses received. 91.7% of respondents had stated that they had gained new knowledge from the session; 87.5% had agreed or strongly agreed that the content was useful and relevant; and 95.8% had agreed or strongly agreed that the speakers were clear, engaging, and knowledgeable about the topics.

The Community Counsellors Sub-Committee (CCSC) organised a workshop event titled "Nervous System 101: Regulation in Action" on 10th October 2024 from 7:30pm to 9:30pm at N9 Offices (Chinatown Point). The workshop, facilitated by Yi Shan, highlighted the critical role of self-regulation in professional counselling, equipping fifty (50) SAC counsellors with neuroscience-based knowledge and neurosensory skills designed to enhance therapeutic safety and alliance with their clients. We were thankful to have in attendance Ms Hema Gurnani (2nd Vice President) and encouraged by the positive responses of SAC members who saw practical benefits in their counselling practice.

A survey was conducted after the event and 94.4% of respondents felt that the event met their expectations, finding the speaker clear, knowledgeable and engaging. 88.9% of respondents found the content and topic useful. All attendees gained new knowledge from the session and expressed their desire to attend future SAC events.

The sub-committee will be organising an online event on 22nd July 2025, where Dr Catherine Toh will be sharing her longitudinal Singapore study entitled, "Am I competent enough as a counsellor?"

The Ethics Board of the Singapore Association for Counselling (SAC) is dedicated to maintaining the highest standards of ethical conduct within the profession. In 2024, the Board continued to uphold these standards by addressing ethics complaints and inquiries, providing guidance to members, and promoting ongoing professional development.

We wish to express our sincere gratitude to Mr Benny Bong, Mr Robin Lim (honorary legal advisor), and Chairperson Rev. Sam Kuna, who stepped down from the Board during 2024 after many years of faithful service. Their dedicated service was instrumental in protecting client welfare and upholding the ethical standards of counselling practice in Singapore, and we are deeply appreciative of their contributions.

Looking forward, we are very pleased to welcome the new members of the Ethics Board. We are delighted to announce the appointment of Ms Denise Yap as co-chairperson, and Ms Stacey Teng as honorary legal advisor. We also extend a warm welcome to Mr Tony Ong, Mdm Linda Koh, and Ms Ng Ai Ling, who have joined the Board as members. We look forward to their contributions to the important work of the Board.

In the year 2024, the Ethics Board addressed five (5) complaints. Of these, three (3) proceeded to a full hearing, one (1) was deemed unsubstantiated, and one undergoing preliminary review at the point of reporting.

The complaints received were categorised as follows:

- Boundary Issues
- Confidentiality Breaches
- Professional Misconduct
- Conflict of Interest
- Inadequate Clinical Practice

These matters often require extensive time commitments from the investigating team, including interviews, document analysis, case discussions, and carefully crafted responses to both complainants and respondents. Throughout the process, the Board prioritises impartiality and strives to prevent further harm to both parties who may have already experienced distress within the counselling context.

Each complaint was thoroughly reviewed and addressed in accordance with the SAC's Code of Ethics. Appropriate actions were taken, ranging from providing additional training and supervision to issuing formal reprimands.

The Board also addressed a number of member inquiries, primarily focusing on the complaints process and its implications, ethical decision-making, clarification of ethical guidelines, professional boundaries, and SAC's position on legal support. The SAC EXCO, in conjunction with the Board, provided comprehensive responses to all inquiries, ensuring members were well-informed and equipped to navigate ethical dilemmas in their practice.

With the increasing complexity in cases being dealt with, a small working group comprising co-chairperson Ms Denise Yap, Ms Vinti Mittal and Ms Stacey Teng has been convened to further refining the ethics manual to guide the ethics board.

As we conclude another year, the Ethics Board would like to encourage all members of the following key points:

- Continually engage in continuing education to enhance your professional knowledge and skills.
- Seek good clinical advice and guidance from experienced colleagues and supervisors.
- Remain vigilant in your professional delivery of service to ensure the highest standards of ethical practice.

By adhering to these principles, we can collectively ensure the integrity and excellence of the counselling profession in Singapore.

The Ethics Board remains committed to supporting members in their ethical practice and addressing any concerns that arise. We look forward to another year of promoting ethical conduct and professional growth within the Singapore Association for Counselling.

The Clinical Supervision Board received eighteen (18) applicants for Registered Clinical Supervisor (RCS), and applications were processed based on guidelines set forth by SAC.

The Clinical Supervision Board Members must unanimously approve the applicants' applications for Registered Clinical Supervisor (RCS) before recommending and submitting these applicants' names to SAC for approval as Registered Supervisors.

Between January 2024 and December 2024, the Clinical Supervision Board received 18 applications. Of these, 17 (95%) were approved, and 1 (6%) was rejected for not meeting the minimum requirement of three years of post-SAC Registered Counsellor status.

There were three (3) applicants whose applications could not be processed due to incomplete submission of documents.

The Clinical Supervision Board Members recommend that the applicants meet the criteria before the Supervision Board processes the applications.

Breakdown of Membership Categories

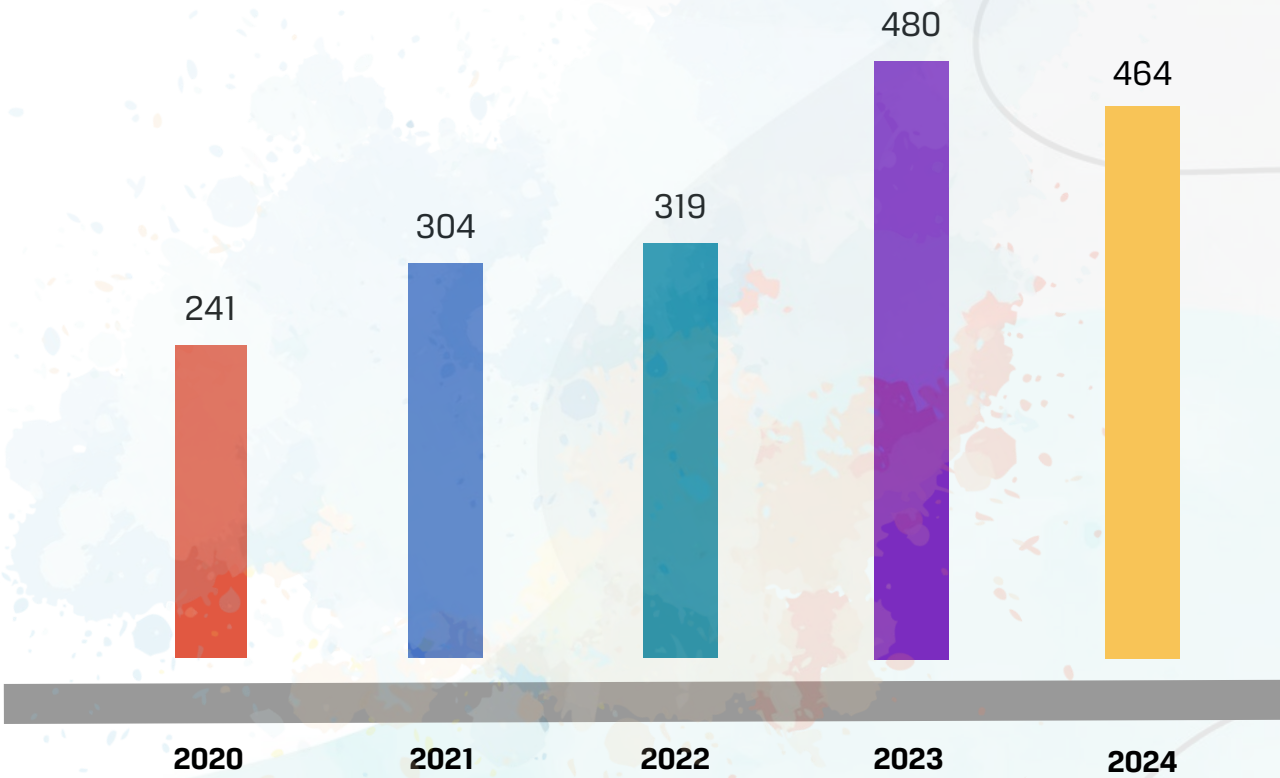
